- 18\_JOB\_38\_01 Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind, and said,
- 18\_JOB\_38\_02 Who [is] this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge?
- 18\_JOB\_38\_03 Gird up now thy loins like a man; for I will demand of thee, and answer thou me.
- 18\_JOB\_38\_04 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- 18\_JOB\_38\_05 Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it?
- 18\_JOB\_38\_06 Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof;
- 18\_JOB\_38\_07 When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?
- 18\_JOB\_38\_08 Or [who] shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth, [as if] it had issued out of the womb?
- 18\_JOB\_38\_09 When I made the cloud the garment thereof, and thick darkness a swaddlingband for it,
- 18\_JOB\_38\_10 And brake up for it my decreed [place], and set bars and doors,
- 18\_JOB\_38\_11 And said, Hitherto shalt thou come, but no further: and here shall thy proud waves be stayed?
- 18\_JOB\_38\_12 Hast thou commanded the morning since thy days; [and] caused the dayspring to know his place;
- 18\_JOB\_38\_13 That it might take hold of the ends of the earth, that the wicked might be shaken out of it?
- 18\_JOB\_38\_14 It is turned as clay [to] the seal; and they stand as a garment.

- 18\_JOB\_38\_19 Where [is] the way [where] light dwelleth? and [as for] darkness, where [is] the place thereof,
- 18\_JOB\_38\_20 That thou shouldest take it to the bound thereof, and that thou shouldest know the paths [to] the house thereof?
- 18\_JOB\_38\_21 Knowest thou [it], because thou wast then born? or [because] the number of thy days [is] great?
- 18\_JOB\_38\_22 Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail,
- 18\_JOB\_38\_23 Which I have reserved against the time of trouble, against the day of battle and war?
