**19\_PSA\_85\_01 To the chief Musician, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. LORD, thou hast been favourable unto thy land: thou hast brought back the captivity of Jacob.**

**19\_PSA\_85\_02 Thou hast forgiven the iniquity of thy people, thou hast covered all their sin. Selah.**

**19\_PSA\_85\_03 Thou hast taken away all thy wrath: thou hast turned [thyself] from the fierceness of thine anger.**

**19\_PSA\_85\_04 Turn us, O God of our salvation, and cause thine anger toward us to cease.**

**19\_PSA\_85\_05 Wilt thou be angry with us for ever? wilt thou draw out thine anger to all generations?**

**19\_PSA\_85\_06 Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?**

**19\_PSA\_85\_07 Show us thy mercy, O LORD, and grant us thy salvation.**

**19\_PSA\_85\_08 I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to folly.**

**19\_PSA\_85\_09 Surely his salvation [is] nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land.**

**19\_PSA\_85\_10 Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed [each other].**

**19\_PSA\_85\_11 Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven.**

**19\_PSA\_85\_12 Yea, the LORD shall give [that which is] good; and our land shall yield her increase.**

**19\_PSA\_85\_13 Righteousness shall go before him; and shall set [us] in the way of his steps.**
