- 20\_PRO\_12\_01 Whoso loveth instruction loveth knowledge: but he that hateth reproof [is] brutish.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_02 A good [man] obtaineth favour of the LORD: but a man of wicked devices will he condemn.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_03 A man shall not be established by wickedness: but the root of the righteous shall not be moved.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_04 A virtuous woman [is] a crown to her husband: but she that maketh ashamed [is] as rottenness in his bones.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_05 The thoughts of the righteous [are] right: [but] the counsels of the wicked [are] deceit.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_06 The words of the wicked [are] to lie in wait for blood: but the mouth of the upright shall deliver them.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_07 The wicked are overthrown, and [are] not: but the house of the righteous shall stand.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_08 A man shall be commended according to his wisdom: but he that is of a perverse heart shall be despised.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_09 [He that is] despised, and hath a servant, [is] better than he that honoureth himself, and lacketh bread.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_10 A righteous [man] regardeth the life of his beast: but the tender mercies of the wicked [are] cruel.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_11 He that tilleth his land shall be satisfied with bread: but he that followeth vain [persons is] void of understanding.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_12 The wicked desireth the net of evil [men]: but the root of the righteous yieldeth [fruit].
- 20\_PRO\_12\_13 The wicked is snared by the transgression of [his] lips: but the just shall come out of trouble.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_14 A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of [his] mouth: and the recompense of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_15 The way of a fool [is] right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel [is] wise.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_16 A fool's wrath is presently known: but a prudent [man] covereth shame.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_17 [He that] speaketh truth showeth forth righteousness: but a false witness deceit.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_18 There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise [is] health.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_19 The lip of truth shall be established for ever: but a lying tongue [is] but for a moment.
- 20\_PRO\_12\_20 Deceit [is] in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counsellors of peace [is] joy.
