- 20\_PRO\_14\_01 Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish plucketh it down with her hands.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_02 He that walketh in his uprightness feareth the LORD: but [he that is] perverse in his ways despiseth him.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_03 In the mouth of the foolish [is] a rod of pride: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_04 Where no oxen [are], the crib [is] clean: but much increase [is] by the strength of the ox.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_05 A faithful witness will not lie: but a false witness will utter lies.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_06 A scorner seeketh wisdom, and [findeth it] not: but knowledge [is] easy unto him that understandeth.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_07 Go from the presence of a foolish man, when thou perceivest not [in him] the lips of knowledge.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_08 The wisdom of the prudent [is] to understand his way: but the folly of fools [is] deceit.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_09 Fools make a mock at sin: but among the righteous [there is] favour.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_10 The heart knoweth his own bitterness; and a stranger doth not intermeddle with his joy.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_11 The house of the wicked shall be overthrown: but the tabernacle of the upright shall flourish.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_12 There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof [are] the ways of death.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_13 Even in laughter the heart is sorrowful; and the end of that mirth [is] heaviness.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_14 The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways: and a good man [shall be satisfied] from himself.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_15 The simple believeth every word: but the prudent [man] looketh well to his going.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_16 A wise [man] feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_17 [He that is] soon angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_18 The simple inherit folly: but the prudent are crowned with knowledge.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_19 The evil bow before the good; and the wicked at the gates of the righteous.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_20 The poor is hated even of his own neighbour: but the rich [hath] many friends.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_21 He that despiseth his neighbour sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy [is] he.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_22 Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and truth [shall be] to them that devise good.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_23 In all labour there is profit: but the talk of the lips [tendeth] only to penury.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_24 The crown of the wise [is] their riches: [but] the foolishness of fools [is] folly.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_25 A true witness delivereth souls: but a deceitful [witness] speaketh lies.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_26 In the fear of the LORD [is] strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_27 The fear of the LORD [is] a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_28 In the multitude of people [is] the king's honour: but in the want of people [is] the destruction of the prince.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_29 [He that is] slow to wrath [is] of great understanding: but [he that is] hasty of spirit exalteth folly.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_30 A sound heart [is] the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_31 He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker: but he that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_32 The wicked is driven away in his wickedness: but the righteous hath hope in his death.
- 20\_PRO\_14\_33 Wisdom resteth in the heart of him that hath understanding: but [that which is] in the midst of fools is made known.
