

Complete KJV Holy Bible

40\_MAT\_23\_01 Then spake Jesus to the multitude, and to his disciples,

40\_MAT\_23\_02 Saying, The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat:

40\_MAT\_23\_03 All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, [that] observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for they say, and do not.

40\_MAT\_23\_04 For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay [them] on men's shoulders; but they [themselves] will not move them with one of their fingers.

40\_MAT\_23\_05 But all their works they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries, and enlarge the borders of their garments,

40\_MAT\_23\_06 And love the uppermost rooms at feasts, and the chief seats in the synagogues,

40\_MAT\_23\_07 And greetings in the markets, and to be called of men, Rabbi, Rabbi.

40\_MAT\_23\_08 But be not ye called Rabbi: for one is your Master, [even] Christ; and all ye are brethren.

40\_MAT\_23\_09 And call no [man] your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.

40\_MAT\_23\_10 Neither be ye called masters: for one is your Master, [even] Christ.

40\_MAT\_23\_11 But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant.

40\_MAT\_23\_12 And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.

40\_MAT\_23\_13 But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in [yourselves], neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.

40\_MAT\_23\_14 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.

40\_MAT\_23\_15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

40\_MAT\_23\_16 Woe unto you, [ye] blind guides, which say, Whosoever shall swear by the temple, it is nothing; but whosoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor!

40\_MAT\_23\_17 [Ye] fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold?

40\_MAT\_23\_18 And, Whosoever shall swear by the altar, it is nothing; but whosoever sweareth by the gift that is upon it, he is guilty.

40\_MAT\_23\_19 [Ye] fools and blind: for whether [is] greater, the gift, or the altar that sanctifieth the gift?

40\_MAT\_23\_20 Whoso therefore shall swear by the altar, sweareth by it, and by all things thereon.

40\_MAT\_23\_21 And whoso shall swear by the temple, sweareth by it, and by him that dwelleth therein.

40\_MAT\_23\_22 And he that shall swear by heaven, sweareth by the throne of God, and by him that sitteth thereon.

40\_MAT\_23\_23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier [matters] of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

40\_MAT\_23\_24 [Ye] blind guides, which strain at a gnat, and swallow a camel.

40\_MAT\_23\_25 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess.

40\_MAT\_23\_26 [Thou] blind Pharisee, cleanse first that [which is] within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also.

40\_MAT\_23\_27 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead [men's] bones, and of all uncleanness.

40\_MAT\_23\_28 Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity.

40\_MAT\_23\_29 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous,

40\_MAT\_23\_30 And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets.

40\_MAT\_23\_31 Wherefore ye be witnesses unto yourselves, that ye are the children of them which killed the prophets.

40\_MAT\_23\_32 Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers.

40\_MAT\_23\_33 [Ye] serpents, [ye] generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?

40\_MAT\_23\_34 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and [some] of them ye shall kill and crucify; and [some] of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute [them] from city to city:

40\_MAT\_23\_35 That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.

40\_MAT\_23\_36 Verily I say unto you, All these things shall come upon this generation.

40\_MAT\_23\_37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, [thou] that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under [her] wings, and ye would not!

40\_MAT\_23\_38 Behold, your house is left unto you desolate.

40\_MAT\_23\_39 For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed [is] he that cometh in the name of the Lord.
